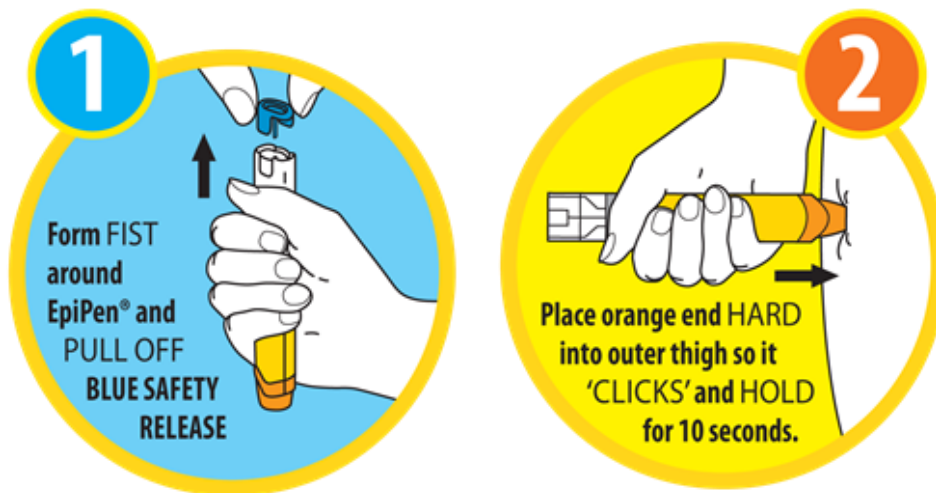


## MEDICATION POLICY

Employees of MWGC are not able to administer medications other than asthma puffers or Epi Pens. Painkillers such as Panadol, Paracetamol and Nurofen cannot be given to gymnasts without written and signed permission of parents or guardians.

### In the event of anaphylactic shock or severe allergic reaction.

The Epi Pens are kept in the white medical drawers just inside reception, here's how to use them,



If you are ever required to use an Epi Pen please call 000 immediately.

If a child is unwell and asks for assistance we will manage the situation with the following steps,

- Try to contact the parent/s or nominated contact
- If we are unable to contact the parent/s or nominated contact we will find somewhere quiet for the child to sit until the parent/s arrive
- If we are unable to contact the parent and the illness becomes serious we will call for emergency assistance
- In the event of any neck, spine, back or severe injury we will call an ambulance.

We would like to remind parents that if a child has a medical condition, we need to know about it.

There is space on our membership form where these can be listed or you can simply notify reception.

If medication or specific permission is required you can discuss this with your coach or administration staff and sign a "permission to manage medication" form.
